The Hartville Chamber of Commerce would like to thank you for registering for the Civil War Heritage Festival on April 24th-26th. We want to make this a great experience for you and us both, so in order to do that, we want to be as organized as possible.

If you are not able to print out a registration form, please e-mail your mailing address to hartvilleareacc@yahoo.com, and we will mail one directly to you. We would like to have as many pre-registered reenactors as possible, and can only guarantee a meal to the ones that are pre-registered.

We are doing everything possible to make your stay comfortable. After you have driven up to the festival location, using the entrance from South Highway 5, please find your spot and unload all your gear. Signs will be in place to direct you where to go. We will be registering and checking in reenactors from 7-10am, on Friday, in the round room, on the back side of the Steele Mansion. Since Friday is a school day, we strongly encourage all reenactors to have their gear unloaded and their vehicle taken to the designated reenactor parking area by 8:30am. **At 8:30am, a shuttle will be waiting at the blue building across the road from Steele Bluff Rd to take you back up to your camps.** We will take the shuttle down to the church again **at 5:00pm** to give all the reenactors who have arrived throughout the day to have a ride back.

Saturday morning, we ask that all reenactors that have arrived throughout the night drive their vehicles down to the parking area to park. **We will have a shuttle waiting at the blue building on Saturday morning, at 8:30am, to shuttle you back up to the Steele Mansion.** We prefer that you register on Saturday morning from 7-10am, but if that isn't possible we can try to figure out a plan b. For the reenactors who have arrived throughout the day on Saturday, you'll need to find a UTV bring you back up to the campsites. Please remember you're responsible for unloading your own gear and finding a ride back up to the campsites if you've missed the shuttle times.
